





How to Login to Google and Access Pearson Realize (enVision Math/Investigations) at Home

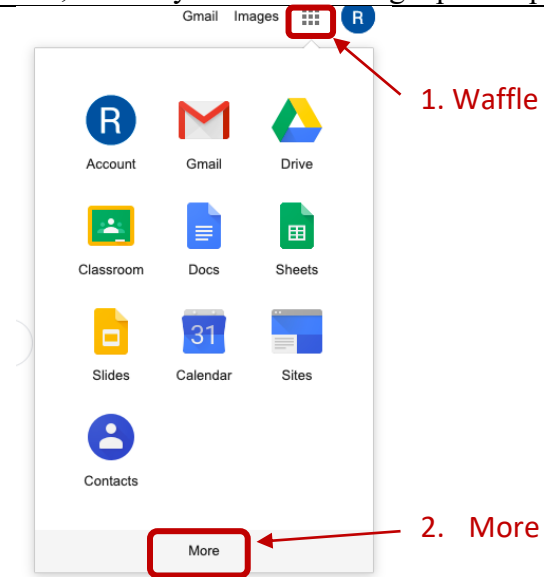

Signing into Pearson Realize (enVision Math/Investigations)
